## Video Discussion & Activity:

- Have you ever felt "replaceable" like the college student in the video? When?
- Older kids: Social media allows for lots of selfexpression. Do you think this makes young people today feel irreplaceable? Why or why not?
- Younger kids: Use an ink pad or marker to take thumb prints of all the family members. Compare them. Did you know you God planned your fingerprints before you were even born? What other ways did God make you "one of a kind"?
- Give each family member a sheet of paper with their name on it. Pass the sheets to the left, and have each person write some ways they see that person reflect God's love in a unique way. Keep passing sheets until they arrive back at the owner. (Older children can be paired with younger to help).
